



Regular Meeting of Webster Township Held February 8, 2016 7:30 A.M.

The meeting opened with the Lord's Prayer.

The minutes of the January 25, 2016 meeting were read and approved.

Correspondence was read from Wood County Sheriff regarding 2015 Webster Township calls.

Resolution 16-003 was read and passed regarding the Township work agreement with the Wood County Engineer. Motion was made by Isaac Bailey to approve spending up to \$50,000.00 on roads with the County Engineer's office for FY 2016. Mark Bushman seconded. Roll call vote – passed unanimously.

Discussion was held regarding the berming machine. The company is in the process of building a new machine for us and recommends not trying to install until spring, after the plowing season.

Discussion was held regarding the garage doors at the Hall. Mark Bushman adjusted them and does not believe that the cement needs to be replaced, but instead, new weather stripping needs to be installed.

Discussion was held regarding newsletter. Isaac Bailey will present it at the next regular meeting for review and approval.

Discussion was held regarding a mailbox policy for those damaged by snowplows. Isaac Bailey to develop a policy for review and approval by Trustees.

Discussion was held regarding road signs throughout the Township. The County Engineer has surveyed the township roads and has found a few delinquencies. The Trustees requested a specific list of the areas which need addressed before taking any action.

Brent Welker spoke to those assembled regarding a proposed business relocating to the Eastwood School District. The unnamed business is interested in perhaps purchasing the Webster School Building. The school building is currently zoned special use, but Mr. Welker discussed perhaps a change in zoning, otherwise the school will need to be razed. There is no current time-line established, but the nursing school has a lease until 12/31/2016. The board plans to move its operations to Pemberville, as well as the preschool, if the central campus is completed. At that point, it will sell Dowling, Luckey, and Webster, and/or demolish them, as may be necessary. The school estimates \$134,000.00 will be spent to demolish Webster. Trustees to inspect the Webster Building on 2-15-16 at 8:00 A.M.
