The meeting opened with the Lord's Prayer. The minutes from the January 9, 2017 meeting were read and approved.

Discussion started with the bills for real estate taxes. Julie Foos explained that after going back and forth with Ottawa County and the Wood County Auditor's Office, everyone agreed that the assessments for the Toussaint Creek project were billed incorrectly. The Auditor's Office decided the best way to handle the issue was to waive the assessments for now. The parcels will be re-assessed when the bids for the Toussaint Creek project come in.

The removal of the trees on Main Road was discussed next. Isaac Bailey mentioned that Bert Buchman is not interested in the job. Jim Cajka noted that Envirocare is interested and was given the go-ahead on the job.

Mark Bushman said that Tom Wolf would like to see some trees removed from the northwest corner of Dunipace Road and State Route 199. Isaac Bailey will talk with the property owner, Wes Brinker about the issue.

Isaac Bailey started the discussion on the Webster School property. He had talked to Brent Welker and was informed that the nursing school will be using the property until July, and the School Board is planning to have an auction there in the fall. So far, everything is still moving according to the expected timeline.

The Wood County Township Association meeting hosted by the Wood County Engineer's Office was discussed next. Julie Foos will RSVP for the three trustees and herself.

Discussion turned to the W-2's for 2016 provided by the Fiscal Officer. Julie Foos explained the issue she had discovered with the current and previous years reporting of wages. She will look into how far back the issue goes and what can or should be done to rectify the situation.

Isaac Bailey started discussing the state-wide grant for road signs. Some townships in the area have received this \$50,000 grant to replace road signs, hardware, and posts. The townships have to be picked by the state and then go to a meeting in Columbus. Isaac Bailey will look into Webster Township's eligibility.

The Trustees briefly talked about the Board of Zoning Appeals meeting coming up to decide on the request for a zoning variance.

Isaac Bailey has tried to contact Mark Moore with the Nexus pipeline to inquire about their timeline. He has not heard anything back.
