The meeting opened with the Lord's Prayer. The minutes from the July 13, 2020 meeting were read and approved.

Mark Bushman has not had any luck in getting a quote from Morton Buildings for a building on the Webster School property but will keep trying.

Julie Foos reviewed the meeting with the Wood County Parks District regarding the playground. The Parks District had many suggestions of ways to improve the playground. Julie Foos set up a meeting with DWA Recreation, a dealer of GameTime equipment. DWA Recreation will come up with a plan for the playground and a proposal for the park grant. The Trustees will see if moving the equipment without damaging it is a possibility. Mark Bushman and Julie Foos will work on figuring out the size of First Energy's right of way. Mark Bushman set up a meeting with Fremont Fence to see how to add more fencing to the top of the backstops. Isaac Bailey mentioned he may be able to get some fencing that Fostoria City Schools tore down. Greg Gonyer is working on setting up a movie night on the ball diamonds to fundraise for the property. Randy Aspacher asked about getting everything out of the old concession stand and tearing it down. Isaac Bailey will talk to the teams about putting up new tile on the fence. The Trustees discussed getting power out to the concession stand. Mark Bushman and Jim Cajka think it would be better to run power to the new building first and then to the concession stand.

Chase Greulich stopped by with some samples of stencils for the cemetery drives and will work on a few more options.

Mark Bushman has not heard back from the County about the corner of Silverwood Road and State Route 105. The stone section of Anderson Road will need graded again before winter, and the County will be getting a big roller the township can use. Joyce Nowak is working on options for limiting unwanted traffic on the stone section of Anderson Road.

The contractor doing the roadside spraying will be in the area at the end of August.

There was nothing to report on the abandoned houses in the township.

Austin Seifert gave his letter of resignation from the Board of Zoning Appeals.

The Trustees discussed the drainage issue on Dunipace Road. The County jetted the tile both directions, so the problem must be in the middle of the field. Isaac Bailey will work with the landowner. The Trustees discussed who will be responsible for expenses since some of the water is coming from the road tile and some from the field tile.

The Trustees talked about removing the tree at the township hall since it had contributed to the issues with the driveway.

The Trustees reviewed the draft of the newsletter and the quote from The Copy Shop. Isaac Bailey made a motion to print the color newsletter through The Copy Shop. Jim Cajka seconded the motion and all were in favor.

Mark Bushman spoke with Dan Muir again about placing a Civil War cannon in Webster Township Cemetery. Mark Bushman will work with the family this fall to make sure everything is done correctly.

The meeting turned to new business. Mark Bushman moved to accept Resolution 20-009, a Resolution to Proceed, Tax in Excess of Ten-Mill Limitation. Jim Cajka seconded the motion and all were in favor in a roll call vote.

The Wood County Engineer's department reviewed the bids from Main Road and confirmed that Gerken Paving, Inc. had the lowest bid. Mark Bushman moved to accept Resolution 20-010, a Resolution Accepting the Lowest Responsible Bid for the Resurfacing of Main Road in Webster Township, Wood County, Ohio. Jim Cajka seconded the motion and all were in favor in a roll call vote. The Trustees signed the contract awarding the project to Gerken Paving, Inc.

Jim Cajka mentioned chip sealing Silverwood Road from Nelson Road to State Route 105. The Trustees discussed other roads that are in need of repair. Swan Road and a section of Anderson Road is getting bad, but both roads are shared with other townships and the Trustees have not been able to work anything out. Jim Cajka will ask Unilliance for a quote on Silverwood Road.


Randy Aspacher asked about the drainage issue on Luckey Road. There is still no answer on who is responsible for it.


