The meeting opened with the Lord's Prayer. The minutes from the July 27, 2020 meeting were read and approved. The Fiscal Officer's report was also approved.

The Trustees began by discussing the Webster School property. Isaac Bailey hauled back some fencing from Fostoria City Schools that could be added to the backstops. Mark Bushman is working on getting a quote from Fremont Fence to extend the backstop.

Isaac Bailey reported the roadsides will be sprayed towards the end of August.

The Trustees reviewed the quotes from Cleary Building Corp. for a storage building and a salt and stone shed. Mark Bushman has not had much luck in getting quotes back, but has scheduled a meeting with Morton Buildings.

Julie Foos notified the Trustees about the rescheduled meeting with DWA Recreation. Mark Bushman and Julie Foos will continue to work on figuring out FirstEnergy's right of way along the playground. The softball teams will host a movie night on August 29 at the Webster School property to fundraise for the ball fields. The teams are hoping to have food trucks come out. The teams have been discussing hosting other events there such as a fall fun night or a car show.

The Trustees reviewed the quote from Unilliance for tar and chipping Silverwood Road from Nelson Road to State Route 105. The Trustees agreed that it seemed too high. Isaac Bailey mentioned he thought the 9's used last year held up really well and would use them again. The County could do it, but they may be booked for this year. Jim Cajka made a motion to let the County tar and chip Silverwood Road either this year or next year. Mark Bushman seconded the motion and all were in favor. Mark Bushman has not heard back from the County about the corner of Silverwood Road and State Route 105. Isaac Bailey said the south end of the stone section of Anderson Road was getting torn up again, but the north end looks good still. Mark Bushman asked Randy Aspacher to take a look at it.

There was nothing to report on abandoned houses or replacements for the zoning boards.

The Trustees discussed some drainage issues in the township. The issue on Dunipace Road is on hold until the beans come off. Isaac Bailey brought up a problem on Alexander Road. The resident wants a swale cut in from a tile to the river. The resident on Luckey Road is waiting on the County to jet the tile causing the problems.

The Trustees and Julie Foos discussed who to send the township newsletter to. Mark Bushman moved to send the newsletter to all residents and taxpayers. Isaac Bailey seconded the motion and all were in favor.

Chase Greulich made some more samples for the stencils for the cemetery drive. Isaac Bailey left the meeting. Jim Cajka and Mark Bushman talked about improvements to Webster Township Cemetery such as buying or renting a portable restroom, pouring a new pad for the portable restroom, and fixing the fence. Julie Foos suggested putting up an information kiosk at the cemetery with the maps when they are completed. The Trustees will try to find an Eagle Scout interested in building one.

The Trustees approved Freedom Township's updated fire and EMS contract for 2020.

The Trustees discussed the specifics of what they want in a building.
