The meeting opened with the Lord's Prayer. The minutes from the August 24, 2020 meeting were read and approved. The minutes from the special meeting on August 31, 2020 were also read and approved. The Fiscal Officer's report was approved.

The Trustees were all happy with how the Main Road project turned out. Isaac Bailey mentioned the Engineer's Department would like to review the final bill before it is paid. Randy Aspacher will start berming Main Road.

The Trustees and Randy Aspacher discussed the quotes for the storage building and compared the contractors and the specs. Julie Foos will follow up with Joyce Nowak about how to proceed. Isaac Bailey made a motion to table the storage building. Mark Bushman seconded the motion and all were in favor. Jim Cajka wanted to make sure everyone is ready to make a decision at the next meeting. The Trustees talked about drainage for the building.

Julie Foos got a map from the Engineer's Department that confirmed FirstEnergy's right of way at the Webster School property along the poles.

Mark Bushman reported Brett Askins with the County has a plan for fixing the corner of Silverwood Road and State Route 105. The County will also remove the catch basin near the corner. The County may still have time to tar and chip Silverwood Road, but Mark Bushman is waiting on a quote. The Trustees discussed using 8's or 9's for tar and chipping.

Isaac Bailey reported the contractor who was going to spray the roadsides will not get to the township's roads this year. Isaac Bailey is going to start spraying them himself. Jim Cajka asked Isaac Bailey to spray the brush around the fence at Old Belleville Ridge Cemetery.

Isaac Bailey reported there were roughly 35 people at the prayer meeting held at the Webster School property on September 11. Isaac Bailey is going to get prices on a flagpole for the property.

Jim Cajka mentioned all the owners of the abandoned houses in the township want more time to get them cleaned up.

Julie Foos is having a hard time finding someone to make stencils for the cemetery drive. The Trustees and Julie Foos discussed the logistics of the Historical Cemetery Walk on October 3. Isaac Bailey will work on ironing out the parking issue. Isaac Bailey moved to accept Resolution 20-012, A Resolution Authorizing the Pemberville Public Library to Hold Its Historical Cemetery Walk in Webster Township Cemetery. Mark Bushman seconded the motion and all were in favor in a roll call vote.

Jim Cajka reported C&L Sanitation does not have any portable restrooms for sale now, but will around the beginning of next year. For now, the township will rent one for the cemetery.

Isaac Bailey mentioned the softball teams have a dumpster on the property now.

Jim Cajka made a motion to install Antonino Violi on the Board of Zoning Appeals. Isaac Bailey seconded the motion, and all were in favor. Antonino Violi will finish the rest of Austin Seifert's term.

Isaac Bailey gathered a few pictures to send to ODOT to prove the township's case for charging for berming Anderson Road and Devils Hole Road. Isaac Bailey will continue to gather documentation.

Isaac Bailey mentioned a resident asked him about trimming some trees. Because the trees are outside of the road right of way, the township is not responsible, but Isaac Bailey will take care of them personally.


Mark Bushman met with Dan Muir and discussed his plans for placing a Civil War cannon at Webster Township Cemetery. Mark Bushman will pour the foundation and will help the family with the installation.


