The meeting opened with the Lord's Prayer. The minutes from the September 27, 2021 meeting were read and approved. The Fiscal Officer's report was also approved.

Jim Bell introduced himself and explained he is running for Troy Township Trustee. Jim Bell discussed the JEDD agreement that Troy Township participates in and his belief that there needs to be more transparency, and then he left the meeting.

Jim Cajka reported the electricity at the storage building is scheduled to be inspected on Tuesday. Randy Aspacher believes the County will do their final inspection at the same time.

The Trustees reviewed a bid for building the shelter house and pouring the concrete pad. The Trustees agreed to apply for the Wood County Park District grant for funds for the materials for the shelter house. Mark Bushman moved to accept Resolution 21-009, a Resolution Authorizing Webster Township to Participate in the Wood County Parks District Local Park Improvement Grant Program. Jim Cajka seconded the motion and both were in favor in a roll call vote.

Mark Bushman reported the County spent a day Durapatching the township roads.

There was nothing to report on abandoned houses, sealing the cemetery drive, the MORE grant, or the ditch cleaning project.

Julie Foos presented a draft of the newsletter. The Trustees approved it, and Julie Foos will send it on to The Copy Shop for printing and mailing.

Mark Bushman mentioned the flagpoles for the Township Hall and Webster Township Cemetery have arrived, but Yankee Doodle Flags and More has not installed them yet.

Julie Foos and the Trustees discussed two potential hall rentals.

Jim Cajka had some suggestions for the kiosk at Webster Township Cemetery such as laminating the list of burials in a binder for people to use while there. Randy Aspacher is going to look into building it.

Randy Aspacher said Isaac Bailey got a call from the gas company about a damaged gas line on Chamberlain Road. The gas company thinks the township mower damaged the line, but Randy Aspacher is confident that is not the case.




