The meeting opened with the Lord's Prayer. The minutes from the November 9, 2020 meeting were read and approved.

Mark Bushman confirmed the only decision left to be made for the storage building at the Webster School property is the colors. The Trustees agreed to a dark brown roof and wainscot with tan sides. Mark Bushman will meet with Lee Frey with Morton Buildings, Inc. to sign the contract and give him the check for the down payment.

There was nothing to report on the donations issue.

Julie Foos reported the Eastwood Community Wreaths Across America event met its goal already and will carry over any extra wreath sponsorships to next year.

Mark Bushman had a phone conference with DTE Energy regarding a new pipeline that will tie into the Nexus pipeline and head north. DTE Energy did not have any maps or many details, as they have not met with landowners yet.

Julie Foos reported the EPA has a grant that could pay for community cleanup programs as well as scrap tire amnesty programs. The Trustees agreed it is worth looking into.

Julie Foos summarized mowing expenses for the year. Isaac Bailey asked if the township should bid the mowing again this year. Isaac Bailey and Mark Bushman agreed to keep the mowing contractors the same if they will continue with the same rate.

Isaac Bailey reported the softball teams are done playing for the year, and will come to a meeting in January to discuss the spring season. Julie Foos relayed her conversations with Joyce Nowak about various issues with the Webster School property.


Mark Bushman mentioned a recent wind storm caused some damage throughout the township. Layman Road was closed for a few days due to leaning telephone poles.
