The meeting opened with the Lord's Prayer. The minutes from the February 28, 2022 meeting were read and approved. The Fiscal Officer's report was also approved.

Chase Greulich began by asking in light of rising gas prices if he could increase the mowing cost for the Webster School property by \$20/mow and Webster Township Cemetery by \$25/mow. Jim Cajka made a motion to pay Chase Greulich the extra money per mow due to rising prices. Isaac Bailey seconded the motion, and all were in favor.

Mark Bushman is waiting to hear back from Home Depot on material costs for the shelter house. Julie Foos is going to continue to research if the shelter house project needs bid out.

Mark Bushman determined there is not enough room between the north ball field and the property line for a walking path around the Webster School property. No one is sure if there is enough room for two legal ball fields if the fencing was moved south to create enough space for the path. The Trustees will meet with Zach Sarver to determine the location of the shelter house. Julie Foos relayed some of the requirements for projects funded by the NatureWorks grant and will keep working through them. Isaac Bailey will check into the prevailing wage aspect.

Randy Aspacher relayed the cost of wire for getting electricity to the concession stand as well as the difference between boring and trenching. The Trustees and Randy Aspacher discussed the pros and cons of each method. Isaac Bailey moved to purchase the wire for the electricity from the building to the concession stand. Jim Cajka seconded the motion, and all were in favor. The Trustees will try to find out more about the tile before deciding on trenching or boring. Randy Aspacher will get a quote for the wiring from an electrician.

Randy Aspacher presented a quote from Sarver & Sons Construction for pouring a concrete floor in the storage building with an apron outside and a pad for the new fuel tank. The Trustees discussed getting quotes for the concrete. Jim Cajka made a motion to accept Sarver & Sons Construction's estimate for the concrete for the building. Mark Bushman seconded the motion, and all were in favor.

The Trustees agreed to wait on a fuel tank until the concrete pad is poured. Jim Cajka would like to sell the old tank on GovDeals.com.

Isaac Bailey would like to have the County drive all the township roads and durapatch whatever needs it. Jim Cajka will have Premier Patching and Unilliance make a recommendation for Nelson Road and the intersection of Silverwood Road and State Route 105. Isaac Bailey will go to Center Township's meeting to see if they are willing to improve the shared paved section of Anderson Road this year. Randy Aspacher has a list of roads that need bermed this year. Isaac Bailey mentioned a resident on Anderson Road has requested it get bermed. Mark Bushman will stay in touch with Jason Sisco at the County about Swan Road.

There was nothing to report on abandoned houses, the cemetery, the sign grant, records retention, selling old equipment, Roadside and Community Clean-up Day, or the health insurance renewal.

The Trustees and Randy Aspacher reviewed Redline Equipment's bill for servicing, installing a block heater, installing a strobe light, and fixing the heat and air conditioning in the tractor. Everyone was shocked by the total. Jim Cajka will go to Redline Equipment to discuss it.

Mark Bushman moved to accept Resolution 22-001, A Resolution Authorizing Permanent Appropriations for Webster Township, Wood County, Ohio as written. Jim Cajka seconded the motion, and all were in favor in a role call vote.

Julie Foos reported Verizon is going to discontinue the township's phone plan at the end of the year and will look into other options.

Isaac Bailey made a motion to accept the Facebook posts Julie Foos prepared. Mark Bushman seconded the motion, and all were in favor.

Mark Bushman got a written request from the estate of Rodney Nixon to refund three unused graves that were previously purchased. The Township has a policy in place to reimburse for unused graves at the original purchase price. Isaac Bailey made a motion to follow the policy. Jim Cajka seconded the motion, and all were in favor.

Randy Aspacher reported the County is going to replace the problem tile on Luckey Road.




