The meeting opened with the Lord's Prayer. The minutes from the March 8, 2021 meeting were read and approved.

The Trustees discussed the bill for roadside spraying. Isaac Bailey made a motion to hold the check until the township receives the spray records. Mark Bushman seconded the motion and all were in favor.

Dave Welling gave his report on zoning. Dave Welling and the Trustees discussed signage, light pollution, and fencing issues. Dave Welling reported some lots on Luckey Road are having problems tying into the Luckey sewer system across the road. Dave Welling did an audit of the township and found some issues including abandoned houses, truck boxes used for storage, junk vehicles, and a building without a permit. Jim Cajka would like to start the process of removing the abandoned houses. Dave Welling is going to send the information to the health department to get the houses inspected.

Mark Bushman reported Morton Buildings still have not provided the engineered drawings needed to obtain County permits. The Trustees discussed who to have peel off the sod and decided the County is the cheapest option. Mark Bushman would like to peel off extra sod and back fill the area with stone instead of having a rat wall. There was nothing to report on electricity. Isaac Bailey reported Sarver and Sons Construction wants to put off the sidewalk project for a few extra weeks. Jim Cajka would like to buy the concrete directly to save on sales tax. Isaac Bailey is still working on a plan to add netting to the top of the backstops. Julie Foos relayed the Prosecutors office's ideas for forms to use the ball fields and concession stand.

The County is going to use the Durapatcher on all of the township roads. Jim Cajka is also going to get a quote from Premier Patching. Mark Bushman sent the County a list of roads to quote. Randy Aspacher reported Liberty Township owns a Durapatcher and would let Webster Township use it if the townships could share labor. All of the Trustees were in favor of the idea. The Trustees talked about which roads need improved, and Julie Foos gave an estimate of how much the township can spend this year on the improvements.

Randy Aspacher brought some samples of stencils for the cemetery drive. Randy Aspacher wants to try some other materials as well before a decision is made.

Jim Cajka reported he bought a portable restroom for Webster Township Cemetery from C&L Sanitation for \$300. The portable restroom can be serviced once a month.

Isaac Bailey mentioned the County had recommendations for the catch basins on Dunipace Road and Silverwood Road. The catch basins will end up flush to the ground.

There was nothing to report on the roadside clean-up event.

Isaac Bailey completed the classes required for the sign grant and is working on figuring out which new signs are needed.

The tree was removed at the township hall, and Isaac Bailey will ask Bert Buchman to grind out the stump. Mark Bushman asked the County to trim the trees on Swan Road, but their bucket truck is broken down.

Isaac Bailey made a motion to accept the health insurance renewal for 2021 with employees paying 25% of the premium. Mark Bushman seconded the motion. Mark Bushman and Isaac Bailey voted in favor, and Jim Cajka voted against. The motion carried.

Julie Foos reported Freedom and Troy Townships agreed to the minor fire and EMS contracts changes and will send over the signed copies.

The Trustees discussed the proposed storm water coalition that was brought up at the Wood County Township Association meeting.

Isaac Bailey made a motion to accept Resolution 21-002, A Resolution Authorizing Permanent Appropriations for Webster Township, Wood County, Ohio as written. Mark Bushman seconded the motion and all were in favor in a roll call vote.

Mark Bushman moved to accept Resolution 21-003, A Resolution Authorizing Webster Township, Wood County, Ohio to Make an Interfund Advance from the General Fund to the Grants and Donations Fund. Jim Cajka seconded the motion and all were in favor in a roll call vote.

Isaac Bailey had Morlocks mow some of the woods on the stone section of Anderson Road. The landowner is willing to pay some of the bill.

The Trustees approved the Purchase Orders and Blanket Certificates for 2021.
