The meeting opened with the Lord's Prayer. The minutes from the March 22, 2021 meeting were read and approved. The Fiscal Officer's report was also approved.

The township received the engineered drawings for the storage building at the Webster School property, and Isaac Bailey is working on getting the township's zoning permit and county permit. The County will peel off the sod and load the dirt to be hauled away. There was nothing to report on electricity, the sidewalk, the backstops, or the softball team contracts. Julie Foos provided an updated quote on the safety surfacing through DWA Recreation, which the Trustees approved.

The Trustees reviewed the quotes from the County for resurfacing a section of Webster Road and for chip sealing sections of Webster, Silverwood, Anderson, Nelson, and Devils Hole Roads. The Trustees also reviewed the quote from Premier Patching for patching a section of Stony Ridge Road. The County did a lot of Durapatching on all of the township roads. Isaac Bailey made a motion to chip seal Devils Hole Road from Luckey Road to Carter Road using 8's and chip seal Silverwood Road from Nelson Road to State Route 105 using 9's. Mark Bushman seconded the motion, and all were in favor. The Trustees reviewed the quotes from Morlock Asphalt for seal coating the township properties. The Trustees discussed buying or splitting a reclaimer with another township.

There was nothing to report on abandoned houses.

Randy Aspacher gave an estimate for making the stencils for Webster Township Cemetery. Isaac Bailey made a motion to move forward with the project using whatever material Randy Aspacher thinks is appropriate. Mark Bushman seconded the motion, and all were in favor.

The County replaced the catch basin on the south side of Dunipace Road and repaired the catch basin on the north side. The County also replaced the catch basin on the southeast corner of Dunipace Road and Silverwood Road.

The Trustees reviewed the bill from the County for the first quarter of 2021.

There was nothing to report on the roadside cleanup event, the sign grant, or the roadside spray records.

Julie Foos reviewed the recommendations from KLA Risk Consulting, part of OTARMA. KLA Risk Consulting recommended implementing various inspections, improving the fuel tanks, and improving the playground and bleachers, among others. Randy Aspacher will have all the fire extinguishers inspected and retagged. Julie Foos will make copies of the various inspection forms. The fuel tank issues will be resolved when new tanks are installed at the new storage building, and the playground issues will be resolved as the new equipment is installed over the next few years.

Isaac Bailey mentioned the Wood County Commissioners voted against the storm water coalition as discussed previously.




