The meeting opened with the Lord's Prayer. The minutes from the April 13, 2020 meeting were read and approved. The Fiscal Officer's report was also approved.

Mark Bushman attended Center Township's meeting and believes they will not be in favor of major improvements to the shared section of Anderson Road.

The meeting turned to old business. The Trustees are waiting on a quote from Morton Buildings regarding a building at the Webster School property. Jim Cajka has not heard back from the Park District regarding the playground. Isaac Bailey has done some work to the ball diamonds.

Mark Bushman has not gotten a response from the County about a bid packet for Main Road or about suggestions for Anderson Road. Randy Aspacher believes Center Township has asked the County to grade the stone section of Anderson Road. Mark Bushman is also waiting for a response from the Prosecutor's office on the legality of limiting access to the stone section of Anderson Road.

The Trustees are still waiting on another bid for improving the township hall driveway.

The Trustees reviewed the bids for seal coating the Webster Township Cemetery. Isaac Bailey made a motion to accept Morlock Asphalt's bid to seal coat the whole thing for \$3,890. Jim Cajka seconded the motion and all were in favor. Julie Foos will put together a list of stencils needed.

Randy Aspacher discussed the berming he did and how much stone was used on Anderson Road. The Trustees debated if it would be cheaper to haul in enough stone to raise the road or have the bank cut down to solve some drainage issues. Julie Foos will prepare a bill for Center Township to pay half of the expenses for the shared section of Anderson Road.

There was nothing to report on the fire and EMS contracts, the roadside spraying program, abandoned houses, 911 address signs, or a new member of the Zoning Commission.

The Trustees agreed to cancel Township Clean-up Day until next year.

Jim Cajka mentioned some ditches have been filling with corn fodder, and the Trustees are unsure of whose responsibility it will be if issues arise.

The Trustees discussed a drainage problem due to the end of a pipe breaking down. The County had replaced the end and made it small enough to be the township's responsibility, but since it is on a county road Isaac Bailey believes it will still be the County's responsibility.

The meeting turned to new business. Dave Welling has issued five permits so far this year. There was a request for a zoning variance, and a meeting is scheduled for May 26.

The Trustees signed the mowing contracts for Chase Greulich.

The Trustees agreed to keep the hall closed for rentals for now.

The Trustees reviewed the figures for the fire and EMS levy. Jim Cajka made a motion to put the 3.1 mill levy on the ballot in the fall and drop the 0.3 mill levy. Isaac Bailey seconded the motion and all were in favor.






