The meeting opened with the Lord's Prayer. The minutes from the May 11, 2020 meeting were read and approved.

The Trustees reviewed Sarver & Sons Construction's bid for replacing the concrete driveway at the township hall. Zach Sarver believes a catch basin is needed. Isaac Bailey made a motion to accept the bid for 6 inch concrete with the catch basin. Mark Bushman seconded the motion and all were in favor. Zach Sarver left the meeting.

Mark Bushman is still waiting for some quotes for a building at the Webster School property. Jim Cajka asked the Parks District for their recommendations for the playground but is not sure if they will send anyone out. Isaac Bailey and Chase Greulich are working on acquiring mulch for the playground. Chase Greulich is willing to volunteer his time to help spread the mulch. Isaac Bailey mentioned the ball diamonds are ready to be used. There are two teams that are interested in utilizing the diamonds, and Isaac Bailey has asked them to provide a schedule.

Mark Bushman reported the County is estimating the Gas Tax distribution will decrease by 15% for the year based on some studies run by the state.

Mark Bushman mentioned the County has graded the stone section of Anderson Road once and would like to do it again. Mark Bushman will contact one of Center Township Trustees to discuss the bill Webster Township sent for half of the cost of improving the road. The Trustees are happy with how the road has held up, but there is a section that still needs more stone.

Mark Bushman confirmed that Jason Sisco is working on preparing a bid packet for improving Main Road.

Julie Foos reported all four townships have received the proposed fire and EMS contracts, but she has not heard back yet.

There was nothing to report on the roadside spraying program or the 911 address signs.

Jim Cajka has been in contact with the owners of five abandoned houses in the township. Jim Cajka would like to implement a timeline of when the houses need to be cleaned up, but would like to talk to each owner one more time before setting the dates.

The Trustees discussed replacements for some empty spots on the Zoning Boards but no action was taken.

Julie Foos read Resolution 20-004, a Resolution of Necessity for Levying Tax Exceeding Ten-Mill Limitation. This resolution will renew the 3.1 mill levy and let the 0.3 mill levy lapse. Mark Bushman moved to accept the resolution as read, and Isaac Bailey seconded motion. All were in favor in a role call vote.

The Trustees and Julie Foos discussed putting together a newsletter to send to all the residents of Webster Township.

Isaac Bailey reported Becky Dippman will order more markers for veterans' graves when she orders flags. Around fifty people attended the Memorial Day ceremony at the Webster Township Cemetery. Residents put up the flags on the veteran's graves at both cemeteries. Chase Greulich will make a new "Closed at Dark" sign. Theresa Bailey put a new flag on the flag pole. The Trustees discussed tearing down the outhouse and renting a portable restroom.

Julie Foos mentioned a resident believes the township should be entitled to compensation for the damage done by the pipeline inspectors to the stone section of Anderson Road. Isaac Bailey will start the discussion with the pipeline.

Julie Foos will prepare a bill to send to ODOT for berming the north section of Anderson Road after the State Route 582 widening project.
