The meeting opened with the Lord's Prayer. The minutes from the September 25, 2023 meeting were read and approved. The Fiscal Officer's report was also approved.

Julie Foos discussed the interest the township received from both Huntington and the new STAR Ohio account.

Mark Bushman moved to accept Resolution 23-013, a Resolution Authorizing Webster Township to Participate in the Wood County Parks District Local Park Improvement Grant Program. Jim Cajka seconded the motion and all were in favor in a roll call vote. Isaac Bailey did not get a bid for additional fencing to use for the grant application. Julie Foos will only prepare one application for the walking path. Isaac Bailey mentioned two of the new trees at the Webster School property will probably not survive.

Isaac Bailey reported the County replaced a road sign that was missing. Isaac Bailey said Unilliance used their hydro vac truck and put in a swale at the intersection of Silverwood Road and State Route 105. The Trustees will see if it improves the drainage in that area.

Julie Foos mentioned she got the maps for the cemetery from the County, but they will not work in the kiosks. Julie Foos will look elsewhere to have them printed. The Trustees agreed to host Wreaths Across America on December 16 at both cemeteries. Matt Hemp will continue to try to install the corkboard in the kiosks. Mark Bushman discussed a rodent problem at the cemetery and will keep trying to get it under control. Mark Bushman mentioned some of the trees have died. Mark Bushman said the row numbers are starting to fade, and the Trustees discussed if the driveway should be resealed.

Randy Aspacher and the Trustees discussed what size auger the new truck should have. Randy Aspacher believes a six inch auger will be sufficient as long as the box can be changed when a nine inch auger is needed.

Randy Aspacher relayed a quote from Streakers for trading in the mower for a new one. Randy Aspacher also asked John Deere and Redline Equipment for a quote and is waiting to hear back.

Matt Hemp reported he took pictures of all the items to sell and the GovDeals.com representative posted the items to sell. However, since the required resolution has not been approved and public notice has not been posted, the sale will need to be taken down until the appropriate time. Julie Foos will work on preparing the resolution and public notice.

Julie Foos reported the newsletter is almost completed. Isaac Bailey made a motion to send the newsletter to all residents and taxpayers when it is done. Jim Cajka seconded the motion, and all were in favor.

Mark Bushman will contact the County about mowing a few roadsides. The Trustees discussed spraying the roadsides. Isaac Bailey will see if the County will let the township use its sprayer.

Isaac Bailey mentioned he is on a committee through the Wood County Township Association regarding regulating solar fields. The Trustees discussed the implications of solar fields.

Randy Aspacher would like to rent a lift to close the vents in the storage building.




