Greg Gonyer began by thanking the Trustees for letting Velocity continue to use the facilities and said he has heard many compliments about how the property has improved over the past few years. People have been using the new shelter house, picnic tables, and bleachers. Greg Gonyer again recommended higher fencing and higher backstops, especially around the south field near the playground, and he and the Trustees discussed the logistics and possible cost. Greg Gonyer discussed the appliances in the concession stand including a new portable sink and believes Velocity is continuing to follow health department regulations. The bases on the south field were moved and some poles on the north field will be moved to square up the fields. Greg Gonyer mentioned the batting cages will need new netting before long. Velocity purchased a pitching machine for the batting cages. An Eagle Scout enclosed the dugouts to provide more shelter. The dumpster and the portable restrooms worked well throughout the year. The Trustees talked about how putting in permanent restrooms would be a major, expensive project. Greg Gonyer thinks a permanent hitting net would be nice but will wait until the walking path is installed to make sure it will be out of the way.

Isaac Bailey is working with the County to get a bid for the walking path. Julie Foos mentioned the township has not received the official award or the contract for the ODNR NatureWorks grant. Jim Cajka asked Greg Gonyer if Velocity is going to apply for more grants, and he said they will apply for the same ones as last year. The Trustees talked about putting up basketball hoops somewhere on the property. Isaac Bailey will see if he can find a portable restroom or two to purchase for the property. The Trustees talked about what could be done to improve the parking lot without repaving it.

Greg Gonyer said the ball teams will start playing again in March and will continue to work with any other teams that want to schedule practices or games on the fields.


