The meeting opened with the Lord's Prayer. The minutes from the November 28, 2022 meeting were read and approved. The Fiscal Officer's report was also approved.

Jim Cajka tried to get in touch with Jeff Dierker about refinishing the office floor, but has not heard back.

Jim Cajka believes Sarver and Sons Construction will begin work on the shelter house soon, and if they don't, Jim Cajka will follow up.

Mark Bushman reported Randy Aspacher and Matt Hemp replaced the pump on the fuel tank after they installed a new security light. Mark Bushman is still looking into a fence to put up around the tank.

Julie Foos got in touch with the Wood County Park District about inspecting the playground, and hopefully they will set up a time with Randy Aspacher to get it done.

No one has contacted Center Township yet about the shared paved section of Anderson Road. Mark Bushman will get the County a list of roadsides that need mowed. Jim Cajka mentioned Silverwood Road needs mowed and some branches need removed. Jim Cajka will call Unilliance about getting their vac truck out to work on the intersection of Silverwood Road and State Route 105. Mark Bushman said the County never did anything about the washout on Silverwood Road, but the stones that were dumped in it seem to be holding. Jim Cajka mentioned ODOT will be using a skidloader with a grinder along state routes throughout the township if needed.

Julie Foos has not heard back yet from the PENTA student about the cemetery maps. The database is just about completed. Julie Foos will look into memorial bricks for the few gravestones that are buried. Isaac Bailey installed the Non-Potable Water sign at the cemetery but not the No Snowmobiling sign. Wreaths Across America will be held on December 17.

There was nothing to report on the members of the zoning boards or the EPA grant.

The Trustees reviewed the temporary appropriations. Jim Cajka moved to accept Resolution 22-009, a Resolution Authorizing Temporary Fund Appropriations and Intra-Fund Transfers for 2023 for Webster Township, Wood County, Ohio. Mark Bushman seconded the motion, and all were in favor in a roll call vote.


