The meeting opened with the Lord's Prayer. The minutes from the special meeting on November 28, 2022 were read and approved. The minutes from the December 12, 2022 meeting were read and approved.

Randy Aspacher and Matt Hemp will put up the No Snowmobiling sign at the cemetery.

Dave Welling reviewed the permits he issued in 2022. Jim Cajka asked about a building that had recently gone up, and Dave Welling confirmed it was for agricultural use. Dave Welling mentioned the Zoning Commission met in December, and they are close to having a revised draft completed.

Randy Aspacher relayed the details on a Tacticam, a security camera that links to a phone that could be installed on the storage building. Randy Aspacher mentioned the small truck needed a new DEF sending unit. Randy Aspacher and Matt Hemp are going to take the big truck to Kalida Equipment to try and get the light issue fixed.

Randy Aspacher and Jim Cajka put away the lumber for the shelter house until Sarver and Sons Construction is ready to build it. Mark Bushman dug out the base of the merry-go-round. Isaac Bailey checked into the building inspection process for the shelter house. Julie Foos reported ODNR did send the reimbursement for the NatureWorks grant, so the process is complete. Randy Aspacher did not hear from the Park District about inspecting the playground, so he will try again in the spring.

There was nothing to report on roads.

Julie Foos called the Wood County Genealogical Society about memorial bricks for marking graves with buried stones, but they do not sell them. Randy Aspacher mentioned he can engrave on stone if needed. The Trustees and Randy Aspacher discussed how to install the bricks so they don't slide or sink. Mark Bushman will talk to a local monument company. Julie Foos reported the Wreaths Across America event went well, but there were less people at Webster Township's two cemeteries than ever before. Julie Foos mentioned there are veterans buried at Old Belleville Ridge Cemetery that no longer have a veteran marker. Mark Bushman would like the township to purchase the markers that are missing. Jim Cajka said someone cut some trees down around Old Belleville Ridge Cemetery and left them outside the fence. Jim Cajka wondered about the trailer next to the cemetery and told Dave Welling it might be time to start getting the few house trailers in the township cleaned up.

Isaac Bailey made a motion to renew Rick Ruffner and Dustin Schimmoeller's terms on the Zoning Commission. Jim Cajka seconded the motion, and all were in favor. Cindy Kistner and Bert Buchman do not want to renew their terms on the Board of Zoning Appeals. Jim Cajka will talk to a resident about joining the Board of Zoning Appeals.

Isaac Bailey does not think the EPA grant will apply to the roadside cleanup program the township has in place, and he does not want to get involved in scrap tire amnesty.

Julie Foos reported the Wood County Park District awarded the township \$4,000 to be used towards benches around the playground at the Webster School property. Julie Foos has to check on the details before the township orders the benches. Julie Foos asked if the Trustees were ready to order the picnic tables for the shelter house since the township will have to pay for them on its own. Jim Cajka does not like the price of the galvanized tables with aluminum tops and thinks the township can build them on its own. Randy Aspacher relayed a quote for renting

a mini excavator with an auger for installing higher fencing around the ball field. Randy Aspacher thinks new poles will be necessary. Isaac Bailey will let Greg Gonyer know.

Mark Bushman moved to accept the road mileage certification for 2022. Jim Cajka seconded the motion, and all were in favor.

Julie Foos presented a list of records that could be disposed of. Mark Bushman moved to dispose of the records listed. Jim Cajka seconded the motion, and all were in favor.

Randy Aspacher reported a Stop Ahead sign had been knocked down. Isaac Bailey will let the County know.




