The meeting opened with the Lord's Prayer. The minutes from the August 8, 2022 meeting were read and approved.

Julie Foos reported the UAN checks only arrived a few days before the meeting. All the warrants approved at the previous meeting will be posted and signed at the current meeting.

Randy Aspacher will look into putting a lock on the new fuel tank. Randy Aspacher has been working on berming the roadsides.

Julie Foos updated the Trustees on the Nexus settlement. Assuming no other appeals are filed, Nexus will owe Webster Township an additional \$22,000 from the past two years.

Isaac Bailey reported the drawing submitted to the County Building Inspection was denied because it was not the right size. Isaac Bailey will have the architect fix the print out and will resubmit it.

The Trustees and Julie Foos reviewed the quotes for picnic tables for the shelter house. Isaac Bailey made a motion to purchase the tables from DuMor and to apply for the Wood County Park District grant to cover 75% of the expense. Jim Cajka seconded the motion, and all were in favor.

Julie Foos showed the Trustees some options for a few pieces of playground equipment that would fit in the unused space. The Trustees would like to see quotes for a new teeter-totter and a few benches. Randy Aspacher and Matt Hemp added stone to the area between the sidewalk and the fence and graded the mulch up to the sidewalk for better accessibility.

Unilliance finished chip sealing all of Chamberlain Road. The Trustees received some complaints about the excess stones. Randy Aspacher informed the County of a washout on Silverwood Road near the township line that needs fixed. Jim Cajka mentioned a resident called about a culvert on Banks Road, but the Trustees agreed it is either an ODOT or private issue. Mark Bushman will talk to the landowner again.

Julie Foos read Resolution 22-004, a Resolution Authorizing Webster Township, Wood County, Ohio to Prepare and Submit an Application to Participate in the Ohio Public Works Commission State Capital Improvement and/or Local Transportation Improvement Program(s) and to Execute Contracts as Required. Mark Bushman moved to accept the resolution. Jim Cajka seconded the motion, and it was approved in a roll call vote. Isaac Bailey confirmed the County completes the application on the township's behalf.

Mark Bushman reported screws were found on Devils Hole Road for the third time, and a sheriff's deputy was going to file another report.

Randy Aspacher questioned if Unilliance worked on the intersection of Silverwood Road and State Route 105. Jim Cajka said they will get to it another time they are in the area. Isaac Bailey will ask the County if they would be willing to do the job.

There was nothing to report on the cell tower on Burgess Road. Independents Fiber contacted Isaac Bailey about another project that will require boring under the roads. Jim Cajka will continue to try to find the right person to discuss the damage to the roads that the installation of the cell tower on Layman Road caused.

Held

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Julie Foos showed the Trustees a sample of the map of Webster Township Cemetery, and they discussed what size the kiosk should be. Isaac Bailey mentioned John Musteric would be willing to use the County's technology to create a map of the cemetery using the marked points already in place.

There was nothing to report on the newsletter or the replacement on the Board of Zoning Appeals.

Randy Aspacher mentioned he would like to add more lights to the storage building. Randy Aspacher would like to use whatever Gross Electric recommends. Isaac Bailey would like to see an external plug installed on the building. Randy Aspacher would also like to add some stone to the south of the storage building and create another bin.

Isaac Bailey mentioned Velocity has a few refrigerators from the concession stand they want to get rid of. Isaac Bailey said Greg Gonyer would like still to improve the backstops with additional fencing. Isaac Bailey will get in touch with Toledo Fence.
