The meeting opened with the Lord's Prayer. The minutes from the August 28, 2023 meeting were read and approved. The Fiscal Officer's report was also approved.

Julie Foos mentioned DWA Recreation will send some touch up paint for the bench at the playground. The Trustees and Julie Foos discussed the options for replacing the big play system and grants that may be available. The Trustees agreed to take the time that is needed to come up with a plan for the big play system rather than rush to apply for grants that are due soon. Isaac Bailey mentioned the used fencing Velocity acquired for the backstops will not work as planned. Isaac Bailey will get a quote for replacing or adding onto the fencing. The Trustees and Julie Foos talked about the Wood County Park District grant and decided to apply for funds for installing a walking path, additional fencing, or a teeter totter.

Jim Cajka would like the County to broom the roads they tar and chipped. Jim Cajka will talk to Unilliance again about improving the intersection of Silverwood Road and State Route 105. Isaac Bailey mentioned he has gotten some phone calls about the new bridge at the intersection of Sugar Ridge Road and Anderson Road. The County will dip out the ditch to improve the drainage issues there.

Isaac Bailey will see if the County is still interested in printing the maps for the cemetery. If not, Julie Foos will look elsewhere.

The Trustees talked about Kalida Equipment's open house and will try to attend to place an order for outfitting the new truck since some of the parts are months out. Randy Aspacher will ask Colin Schifer with Fremont Volvo when the new truck is slated to be built.

Julie Foos reported the STAR Ohio account has been funded and will monitor it.

There was nothing to report on the items to sell.

Isaac Bailey asked Randy Aspacher and Matt Hemp to drag the stone section of Anderson Road again before harvest season starts.
